There is new scheme for examination and evaluation given by CBSE to schools as follows

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION AND EVALUATION

As per the new CBSE format for examination and evaluation, the main points of process of evaluation for Session 2017-18 will be as follows:

Classes VI to VIII

The subjects that each student will have to study are Hindi, English Course 'A', Sanskrit, Mathematics, Science & Technology, Social Science, Dharamshiksha (Hindi Medium).

In addition to the above subjects the students will be offered other subjects such as General Knowledge, Art Education, Computer Science and Physical & Health Education.

There will be two examinations in an academic year for the 1st term/half yearly from April to September and 2nd term/annual from October to March. The question paper of each subject will be of 80 marks for the classes 6 and 7 and for 100 marks for class 8.

- There will be three Unit Tests and two terms (half yearly and annual)
- There will be no Unit test of General Knowledge, Computer and DharamShiksha Subjects.

WEIGHTAGE:

Unit Test – 10% ,Half yearly – 20% , Annual – 60% , Note Books – 5% , ASL/Activity - 5%

1. Written exam will not be rescheduled if the child is unable to appear for the same.
2. In case of any leave, a leave application /Medical certificate has to be submitted to the class teacher positively.
3. The student is required to score 'A1' grade overall and 'A' grade in subsidiary subjects to be eligible for the merit award.
4. It is mandatory for a student to qualify term I examination by scoring at least 25% marks in written examination to be able to appear for term II.
