- The school shall remain closed for the summer vacations as per given schedule :

Classes III to VII, IX & XI	:	<b>20<sup>th</sup> May to 2<sup>nd</sup> Jul'17</b>
Classes VIII , X & XII	:	<b>29<sup>th</sup> May to 2<sup>nd</sup> Jul'17</b>

School will re-open on **03<sup>rd</sup> Jul'17** at its usual timings. However, the school office shall remain open during the vacations (**Timings : 8.30 a.m – 11.30 a.m**).

- Extra **classes for VIII, X & XII** will be held from **22<sup>nd</sup> May to 27<sup>th</sup> May'17 (Timings 7.30 a.m – 12.00 a.m)**. Attending extra classes is compulsory must for all the students of above mentioned classes.
- To keep abreast of the ongoing sessions, **creative assignments** are being given as **Holidays Homework**. Encourage your ward to put sincere efforts in preparing projects assigned to them. The school will organize the **HOLIDAYS HOMEWORK** exhibition on the first PTM i.e, after the school reopens.
- Kindly restrict the use of thermocol sheets, big size chart papers, wooden projects and readymade projects from market as the use of such items is not eco friendly. Make sure the assignments are made sincerely and kept intact in bag. The projects must be submitted to the concerned subject teachers on the very first day of reopening of school i.e, **03<sup>rd</sup> Jul'017**. There will be a unit test for Classes III to X in the third week of July 2017.

- Selection/Revision test for classes X, XI & XII will commence from end of June 2017 for which Date Sheet will be circulated to students by the concerned Coordinator. Absentees in Extra Classes & Selection Tests will have to stay back/ reappear in test.
- Kindly attend the **Parent Teacher Meeting on Saturday, 20<sup>th</sup> May'17** and discuss the performance of your ward in the first Unit Test.
- There will be no written examination/Pen Paper test of ICT for the Classes III to VIII.
- Please note that **Annual Charges along with the fee for the month of April** must have been paid and fee for the month of May & June is to be paid in May up to 15<sup>th</sup>. Fee depositing time during summer vacation will be 8:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Kindly cooperate and **deposit the fees by cheque only**.
- It is for the notification of the parents that the timings to meet the Coordinators are between **7.15 a.m to 8.10 a.m and 1.30 p.m to 1.50 p.m.** and timings to meet the Principal – **10.00 a.m to 11.30 a.m** on all working days. Apart from these timings kindly visit school with prior appointment as classes go on and Coordinators/teachers are not supposed to leave the class.
- For meeting a teacher or Coordinator the parents are requested to **contact at the reception first** from where they will be directed to the concerned person. This has been devised for the convenience of the parents. Please maintain the decorum of the institution.
- No outsider is allowed to move in the corridors during school working hours to ensure safety & security of the children.
- **Date sheet for Selection Test for Classes X, XI and XII is given below.** Kindly help your ward in preparing for these examinations during the Summer Vacation. It is very important to prepare sincerely for these **Tests** as it helps them to perform better in term examination.
