Career counselling

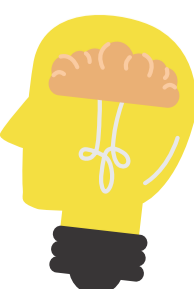
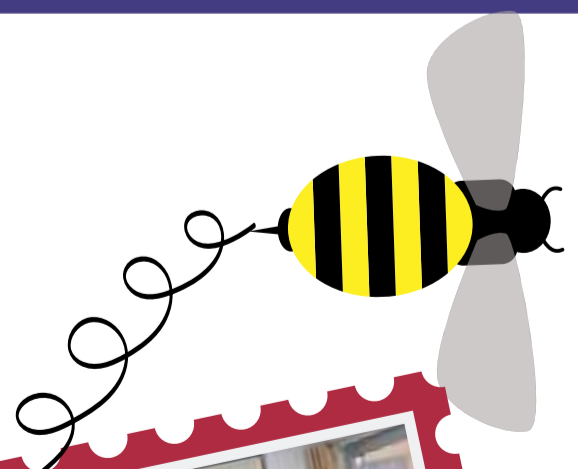
"Your future depends on what you do today."

"Learning should be an enjoyable, fulfilling and endless journey".

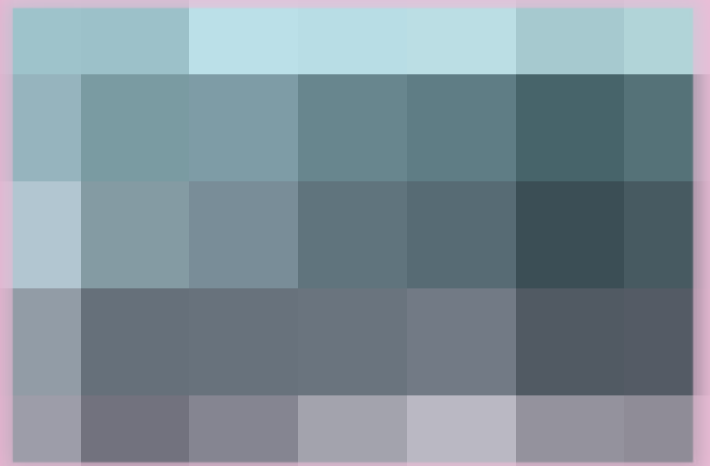

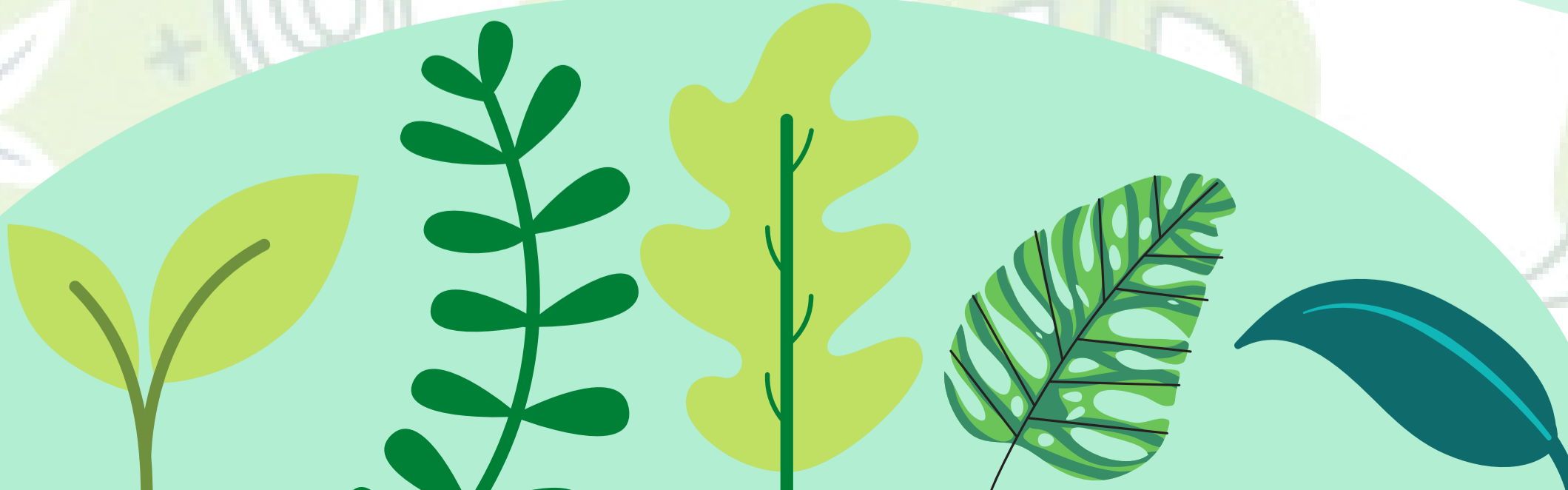
